
The Sabbath was made for Man


Ikaria, Greece

The Sabbath was made to remind us of creation


The word "Sabbath" comes from the Hebrew "Shabbat" which means "rest" or "cessation."

Shabbat directly recalls the Biblical Creation of 6 days as described in Genesis. It is a direct link to our creation and the One who created us!


Genesis shows us how truly unique the Creator is



The Hebrew story of creation is much different than the creation stories found in other cultures.

In Greek Mythology the gods act much like petty, violent children constantly fighting with one another.

In Norse Mythology the creation occurs out of a war and from the dead body of a giant.



How different is the Genesis story! God moves peacefully, with no fanfare and no battle around him. He simply speaks and our world and all its creatures are put into place. Unlike the other gods who are only concerned about their own interests,

God creates with us in mind!









The 6 days of creation described in Genesis show God to be the great Provider for His creations:

A source of energy is provided - Day 1

All needed materials put in place (soil, water, oxygen) - Days 2 and 3

Vegetation provides food, there is no shortage - Day 3

The Moon and Sun are given to light the Earth - Day 4

Diversity of life is created - Days 5 and 6

A manager is appointed to work with God in keeping the creation pure and healthy - Day 6 Peace reigns, there is no violence or death - Day 7

And on top of all we need to survive, God created beauty to surround us and remind us of Him.
